

SIGMICRO Distinguished Service Award – Call for Nominations

We seek nominations by October 11 for the 2021 SIGMICRO Distinguished Service Award. This annual award is presented to an individual who has contributed important service to the processor microarchitecture and microsystems community while also serving as an active member of SIGMICRO who has contributed (or is contributing) significantly to SIGMICRO organization and/or SIGMICRO-sponsored conference committees.

Nominations

Nominations may be submitted at any time on the submission website:

To be considered for 2021, the nomination and all endorsements must be received by October 11. A nomination for the Distinguished Service Award that is not awarded may remain valid for consideration in future years.

Each nomination should consist of the following:

- Name, email address, and phone number of the person making the nomination (the nominator).
- Name, address, phone number, and email address of the candidate for whom an award is recommended (the nominee).
- A short statement (200-500 words) explaining why the nominee deserves the award in question.
- Invitations via the nomination page on website above to 3-4 people to endorse the nomination.

Self-nominations are not allowed.

Recognition

The award recipient receives a memento engraved with their name along with a \$1000 honorarium. The award is presented by the SIGMICRO Chair at MICRO during MICRO's award presentation session. The award recipient may receive up to \$2000 towards MICRO conference registration, and when attendance is not virtual, support for travel costs such as airfare and hotel. Additional travel support may be provided at the discretion of the SIGMICRO Executive Committee.
